

### Transit Station Information

Walton Township subsidizes a transit station for its residents' use. For \$75.00, you may purchase a permit that allows you to get rid of **your household trash** (only items that you would be able to put in curbside receptacles.) A permit is required for each household that is using the transit station.

The station is located at: Butterfield Hwy, Olivet (about 1/3 mile west of Olivet on south side.) The hours are: **Tuesdays from 3:30 p.m. to 5:30 p.m. and Saturdays from 7:30 a.m. to 11:00 a.m.** or until full. The station is closed on major holidays.

The transit station is provided by Walton Township as a service to its residents. In order to continue to provide this service and keep cost to residents at a minimum, please respect the following guidelines:

- Use of Transit Station is available to **WALTON TOWNSHIP RESIDENTS ONLY**. You must provide proof of residency to purchase a permit and have it available each time you dump.
- Trash that is produced at **The PERMIT HOLDER'S HOUSEHOLD ONLY IS ALLOWED TO BE DUMPED**.
- The station is meant for **personal use only**. If you have a business that produces trash, you are not eligible to dump it at the transit station.
- **No hazardous wastes** are allowed to be dumped.
- **No construction materials** are allowed to be dumped.
- There is a scrap metal dumpster and a cardboard dumpster available at the station.
- Remember there is a recycling station at the transit station that is available on Wednesdays to the public. Help us accommodate mire residents by recycling.
- It is expected that you have a reasonable amount of trash. (We are getting regular complaints of truckloads of trash being dumped each week by the same people.)
- Walton township officials and personnel have the right to limit amount of trash disposed by individuals.
- **ABUSERS WILL HAVE THEIR USE PRIVILEGES REVOKED.**
- Permit costs are nonrefundable and are not prorated.

***We want to ensure the future of this service and can only do it if we all respect the guidelines.***

Dump permits are available for purchase as of August 1 for the period of August 1 through July 31. You may send a check to treasurer payable to Walton Township in the amount of \$75.00.
