

## Walton Township Transit Station Information

Walton Township provides a transit station located on Butterfield Hwy, 1/3 of a mile west of Olivet, for WALTON TOWNSHIP RESIDENTS ONLY. For \$75.00, you can purchase a permit that allows you to dispose of household trash (only items that would be allowed to be disposed of through curbside receptacles.) **Permits are VALID from August 1<sup>st</sup> through July 31<sup>st</sup>.**

Dump permits can be purchased by contacting Jeanine Nowak, Treasurer or by mailing \$75.00 to Jeanine Nowak at 4659 S Bradley Rd Charlotte, MI 48813. To purchase a permit in person, please contact the Treasurer to setup a time.

The hours are as follows:

**Tuesdays 3:30p.m. until 5:30p.m. and Saturdays 7:30a.m. until 11:00a.m. or until containers are full.**

The station is CLOSED on major holidays.

In order to continue to provide this service to residents and keep our costs to a minimum, please respect the following guidelines:

- Disposal of household trash only
- Businesses are not eligible for disposal.
- No hazardous wastes
- No construction materials
- Disposal of scrape metal should be disposed in the metal bin.
- Disposal of cardboard should be disposed in the cardboard bin.
- We expect you to have a reasonable amount of trash per drop off.
- Walton township officials and personnel have the right to limit trash disposal.
- **Violators of the guidelines shall have their permit revoked.**
- Permit costs are nonrefundable and are not subject to being prorated.
