A. Fire Truck Purchase - Action Item

Fire Commissioner Don Walker asked Fire Chief John Collins "If he was able to secure a better discount rate than the initial 3% offered." Collins stated that Spencer Manufacturing increased the discount rate from 3% to 3.5% on any downpayment. He said that the State of Michigan Grant will advance \$500,000.00 as a downpayment and is asking for the Council's thoughts on putting additional money down from the equipment rental fund. Collins stated the savings from the discount would go towards the \$80,000.00 to \$100,000.00 needed to equip the fire truck. Collins is asking the Council to sign a contract with Spencer Manufacturing that will lock in the price of \$924,568.00 for the designated fire truck. Discussion took place regarding equipment and equipment warranties for the truck, interest rates earned on the General Fund balance versus the discount rate being offered on the downpayment, timing on reimbursement of funds, and the risk of decreasing the General Fund balance for an extended period of time.

MOTION by Walker, supported by Frohm, to approve signing the contract with Spencer Manufacturing to purchase the designated fire truck for \$924,568.00 with a discount of 3.5% on the \$500,000.00 advanced down payment from the State of Michigan grant. Motion carried 6-0.
