LEAF PICK-UP

WILL BE OCTOBER 14 - NOVEMBER 30

Please have your leaves along the curb (not in the street), free of sticks, rocks, and other debris. You may also take your leaves to the Compost Site at 4275 W. Butterfield Hwy.



HYDRANT FLUSHING

OCTOBER 15 – 18 Weather Permitting

Remember, there may be the normal discoloration and change in pressure. To help clear the water discoloration, run your cold water for about 10 minutes.

CODE ENFORCEMENT

- ❖ Do not blow lawn clippings and sticks into the sidewalks or roads.
- ❖ Animals running loose is prohibited.
- ❖ Clean up after your dog.
- ❖ Make sure your animals do not become a nuisance in the neighborhood due to noise and destructive behavior.
